Venue and travel information

Wifi:

IMPORTANT! There is free wifi access in all airports, all the intercity trains ("wifi in de trein"), as well as in the bus Flixbus (according to the website) and the public transportation.

In the Radboud you can connect to the Free wifi access "gasten-UMCRadboud" or use EDUROAM using your own EDUROAM login.

Airports:



It is possible to reach Nijmegen from different airports:

- From Düsseldorf Weeze airport (Germany): ~45 min
This airport is the closest to Nijmegen. A shuttle-bus from the airport arrives directly at the train station of Nijmegen.







The shuttle-bus leaves from bus stop N° 5 that you will find just on the right when you go out of the airport. Reservation necessary at least 24 hours before. Shuttle website: http://www.airport-weeze-shuttle.de/

- From Amsterdam Schiphol airport: ~1h30
 - Schiphol is a big airport and the main advantage is that the train station is in the basement of the airport itself. From there take a direct train called "intercity" Amsterdam Schiphol-Nijmegen or with a change in Utrecht Centraal. See train information below.
- From Eindhoven airport: ~1h30
 - It is a small airport and you can reach Eindhoven train station by bus (Line 401 "richting"=direction Eindhoven Station). Then take a train "intercity" richting Amsterdam Centraal, change in 's-Hertogenbosch to Nijmegen. See train information below.
- From Rotterdam airport: ~2h10
 - It is also a small airport and you can reach Rotterdam train station by bus (Line 33 richting Centraal Station via Airport). Then take a train "intercity" to Utrecht Centraal, and change there to Nijmegen. See train information below.

Trains:

General advise: Avoid to take the train "Sprinter" which will stop in EVERY possible city/village. It will make your travel much longer! Instead, go preferably to "Intercity" trains.




Mercure hotel is right next to the train station, at the bottom of this map.

The REMIX Annual Meeting on Monday Nov 13th, 2017, will start at 10.00 am with a Welcome Coffee and will take place at the Fidgor lecture theater of the RIMLS (Radboud Institute for Molecular Life Sciences) on the 8th floor http://www.rimls.nl/

!!!!The fellows meeting, also on Monday Nov 13th, from 09.15 am until 10.00 am, will take place in a different meeting room called Cristian de Duve, which is on route 831a (see below 'signposting system'). Fellows should gather in front of the RIMLS at 09.00 (see map) so the Nijmegen fellows can pick you all up and take you to that meeting room. At 10, the Nijmegen fellows will guide you to the Fidgor lecture theatre.

The easiest way to get there by public transportation is to catch a bus from Nijmegen train station. Several bus lines bring you there in about 15 minutes: 6,10,83,14,300.



According to the bus line you catch, you should get off at the following stop:

- Radboud UMC Bus Station https://goo.gl/maps/pQk2HsYm8YR2
 - 6 direction Neerbosch-Oost
 - 10 direction Nijmegen CS
 - 83 direction Venlo
- Huygensgebouw Bus Station https://goo.gl/maps/Si1dsqi9mUT2
 - 14 direction Brakkenstein
 - 300 direction Heyendaal

You can buy a bus ticket for about 3€ (one way) directly on the bus but keep in mind to bring the change, or you can also use the OV-chip card.

Signposting system

The Radboudumc uses a signposting system with route numbers. Each department has its own route number. You will find information boards in Dutch stating the department route numbers near the main entrance. These route numbers enable you to follow the numbered signs from the entrance to the department in question.
